
How to apply to an Accelerated Program at the Richard M. Fairbanks School of Public Health

- 2. Select Academics from the top menu.




3. Select Undergraduate Degrees & Minors from drop down menu.





The following picture should be displayed after clicking on the Accelerated application form button located on each of the program's academics webpage.




Click arrow to start application.



Letter of Recommendation and Academic Reference

All applicants are required to submit one professional letter of recommendation and list one IU Indianapolis faculty member they would like to have serve as a reference for their application.

Professional Letter of Recommendation

Your letter writer should be someone who has worked with you in a professional context. This might be a past supervisor, internship mentor, faculty member you've served as a teaching assistant for, or some other individual you have worked with. Please request that your letter writer submit their letter (PDF) via email to Ms. Cher Pearcy at chepearc@iu.edu. This letter must be submitted by the application deadline. Also, ask your writer to use the following naming convention: applicant's last name, first name - LOR. For example: Jaguar, Jinx - LOR.pdf.








Do you have dual citizenship?






State of Residence






Personal Statement

Your personal statement is an opportunity to highlight your background, experience and interests that influenced your decision to apply to our accelerated program. You may also use the personal statement to explain any inconsistencies in other components of the application. Generally, personal statements of around 500 words are most effective. Review your program's personal statement requirements, visit the Accelerated Degrees webpage.
